Our 2023 results for our top performing Year 12 students are cause for celebration. In an ever-changing world, these graduates have demonstrated resilience, determination and unwavering commitment to their education. The purpose of this publication is to highlight not only our students' individual success stories, but to also extend our collective congratulations to each and every student for their personal achievements and positive impact on the wider College community.

The extraordinary achievements from our students have seen an increased number of graduates gaining ATARs in the mid-80s or above, with our top ATAR score of 99.7. MRC had 97% of its students satisfactorily completing their VCE and 94% of students receiving first round tertiary student placement offers. It is a rewarding experience when our graduate students achieve their personal goals and gain entry into either their nominated tertiary course or field of employment.

Such achievements would not have been possible without the close collaboration between staff, parents and carers who have supported our students during their school years. 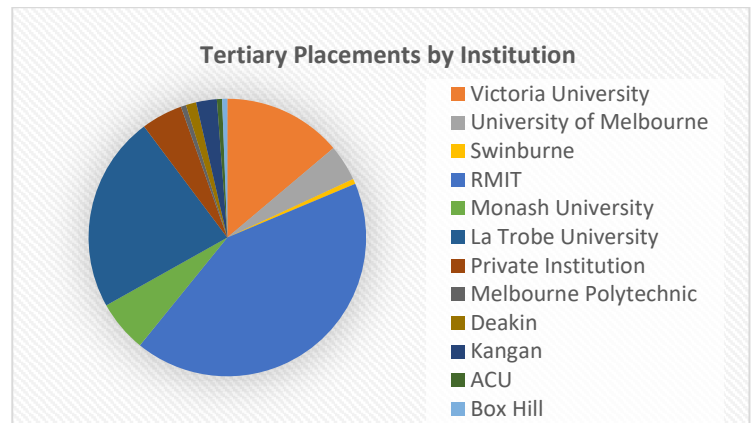
